Agreement on activity exchange between

The Geological Society of Korea

and

The Geochemical Society of Japan

The Geological Society of Korea (GSK) and Geochemical Society of Japan (GSJ)(hereafter referred to the two societies), in the conviction that the activity between the two societies will promote scientific research and communication for the benefit of geochemistry, hereby conclude the following agreements.

Article 1. The two societies agree to have mutual discussion on cooperative and collaborative activities for

promoting scientific research. This agreement defines the principles and methods of cooperation that the

GSK and GSJ wish to develop between them under equal partnership.

Article 2. In order to support theactivity stated in Article 1, the two societies agree to promote and support

their member's contribution to and attendance at annual meetings of two societies and V. M.

GoldscmidtConferencesTM, a broad-scope conference covering all aspects of geochemistry,

cosmochemistry, and geology.

Article 3. The two societies agree to carry outthe above activities in accordance with the laws andregulations

of the respective countries after full consultation and approval of both Societies. It is understood that

implementation of any type of cooperation stated in Article 2 may be restricteddepending upon the

availability of resources and financial support. The execution of this agreementwill not cause any

financial obligations to either Society.

Article 4. This Agreement is valid for five years effective from the date of the final signature affixed below

by the two societies. The term of the Agreement is extended unless either party expresses theintention of

terminating the Agreement. Either party may terminate the Agreement during the five years term by

giving a written notice to the other party six months in advance

Article 5. This Agreement is executed only in English.
