have resolved to conclude the following

Agreement of Association

- 1.** GSJ shall be an Associated Society of EAGE.
- 2.** EAGE shall provide GSJ with the following:
 - a. Mention of GSJ as an Associated Society in the EAGE website and in relevant communications, including a link to the website of GSJ;
 - b. Listing of one event of choice organized by GSJ in the EAGE calendar of events at www.EAGE.org and in the calendar (online and printed) of First Break, with a direct link to the event website;
 - c. Possibility of requesting free webinars from the EAGE Distinguished Lecturer Programme (DLP) to be offered to the members of GSJ;
 - d. Possibility for the members of GSJ to access EAGE Education Programmes (including in-person courses, self-paced courses, extensive online courses and interactive online short courses) at a discounted fee equal to the EAGE Bronze level member pricing;
 - e. Possibility for the student members of GSJ to access EAGE Student webinars;
 - f. A free physical display in the Associated Society Area at the EAGE Annual Conference & Exhibition, including either one full delegate pass or two exhibition-only passes, enabling GSJ to promote its society and activities at the event;
 - g. Possibility for the members of GSJ to register for selected EAGE events at a discounted fee equal to EAGE member pricing;
 - h. Possible support and cooperation on matters such as the organization and promotion of local seminars, workshops or other scientific gatherings, subject to approval of the EAGE Board;
- 3.** EAGE shall be an Associated Society of GSJ.
- 4.** GSJ shall support EAGE with the following:
 - a. Mention of EAGE as an Associated Society in the website of GSJ and in relevant communications, including a link to www.EAGE.org, where applicable;
 - b. Listing of one event of choice organized by EAGE in the Announcement page of GSJ website, with a direct link to the event website;
 - c. Possibility to have news items or announcements published in GSJ publications and newsletters, subject to final editorial authority of the editors;

- d. Promote EAGE education offerings with a direct link to LearningGeoscience.org in the GSJ website under the Event page;
- e. Possibility to have quarterly promotional emails and/or social media posts to the members of GSJ highlighting EAGE education offerings;
- f. Possible support and cooperation on matters such as the organization and promotion of local seminars, workshops or other scientific gatherings, subject to approval of the GSJ Board;

5. More specific ways of cooperation between EAGE and GSJ will be covered in separate agreements.

6. This Agreement shall become effective when signed by both parties and shall remain in force until terminated by either party upon giving written notice to the other party.
